Bring your sneakers, bike or horse and join RTA as we explore the rolling hills and ancient oaks of the serene Santa Ysabel Valley. This year we are offering overnight camping in this beautiful primitive setting for those who would like to stay over and enjoy a continental breakfast and an additional ride/hike on Sunday morning. You will need to provide your own portable corral or tie to your trailer for the night. There will be porta poties, but you will need to otherwise be fully self-contained, including water and feed for your horses.

Saturday's events include a 3 hour ride or hike and then feast on our famous Santa Maria style BBQ with all the fixin's, a raffle and the opportunity to bid on fantastic silent auction items. We will have wine tasting available to sample local wines. Members of the Ramona Valley Vineyard Association will display their wines and several will be available for purchase. Sunday morning we will provide a continental breakfast before heading out for another ride/hike. Please note, the overnight option is limited only to those who have participated in the Saturday's event.

Early registration post marked by June 1st gets you a \$10 discount! Sorry, but we cannot offer refunds after June 15th.

Check in on Saturday no later than 9:30 with last rider out at 10. Saturday's lunch will be served at 12:30pm and continue until everyone is full. Raffle prizes will be awarded during lunch and the silent auction will close at 2:30pm.
